**Call to Order:**

Mayor Gaddy called the meeting to order at 6:15 p.m.

**Invocation:**

Councilman John McMeekin offered the Invocation.

**Approval of Minutes:**

Councilwoman Janice Bartell Prather made a motion to accept the minutes with a seconded by Mayor Pro-tem Sanders that the minutes of the October 6, 2018, Town Council Meetings be approved as written. All voted aye.

**Public Comments:**

Ms. Wanda Carnes spoke on the fund raiser being held on October 20<sup>th</sup> for the Fairfield Co. Animal Shelter. Ms. Carnes also stated that Dru Blair would start on October 23<sup>rd</sup> painting the mural on the building she owns next to the town clock. Ms. Carnes requested assistance in closing the parking lot owned by the town.

Ms. Vanessa Reynolds spoke on the lack of communication and cooperation from the Fairfield Chamber of Commerce for Rock Around the Clock. Ms. Reynolds reported on the upcoming Pumpkin Fest planned for October 27<sup>th</sup>. Ms. Reynolds requested permission to tie the cornstalks to the decorative poles. Mr. Medlin stated it would not be a problem.

Mr. Bob Prather, FCC Board Member, stated he conducted one of the merchant meetings where the Rock Around the Clock was discussed in length and the staff had offered to assist the Car Show group (Mr. Stone) with filling out any necessary paper work for their car show since they did not want to be part of the car show within the Rock Around the Clock. Chief Seibles added that the group did not submit any of the necessary paper work to Public Safety for the closing of the street.

**New Business:**

- A. Resolution #R2018-10618A MASC Collection Agent for Delinquent Set Off Debt** The Resolution was discussed in the Finance Meeting and the resolution comes with a recommendation for the Finance Committee to Council. Council voted in favor of accepting the Resolution R2018-10158A.
- B. Ordinance #2018-1016B Collection Costs Recovery for Delinquent Set Off Debts** – First Reading was presented to Council with a recommendation from the Finance Committee. Council voted in favor of the ordinance. A public hearing and second reading will be held on November 6, 2018.
- C. Ordinance #101618C Donation of Fortune Springs Park Pool to Fairfield County**-The ordinance was presented to Council for first reading. Mayor Pro-tem Sanders made a motion to accept first reading as presented with a second by Councilwoman Janice Bartell-Prather. All voted aye.
- D. Capital Expenditure Request**-Otis Williams Water Plant Director. Mr. Williams requested four items totaling \$46,000.00

**Old Business:** None




