- a. Capital Expense Request: Wastewater Plant – Sammie Robinson, Director  
The Finance Committee is recommending the approval of the request from Mr. Robinson to purchase a Trough for the Wastewater Plant. The current Trough is over 50 years old and cannot be repaired. The cost of this equipment continues to increase. The lowest bid was from Bearing Distributors for \$35,421.20. Council voted in favor of the purchase.
- b. Armory Use Request: Richard Winn Academy  
The RWA Booster Club is requesting to use the Armory for their Athletic Banquet on May 14, 2021. Councilman Miller made a motion to approve the request and for the

gratis fee of \$200.00 with the school cleaning up after the banquet. Councilman Chatman seconded the motion and all voted aye.

- c. Councilman Chatman inquired about the House of Prayer Banquet that was planned before Covid and was postponed due to Covid. The church is requesting to use the Armory on May 15, 2021, for their banquet. Councilman Chatman made a motion to approve the request with the gratis fee of \$200.00. Mayor Pro-tem McMeekin seconded the motion. All voted aye.


