MINUTES FINANCE COMMITTEE MEETING WINNSBORO TOWN COUNCIL NOVEMBER 15, 2022

1. CALL TO ORDER

3. PRESENTATIONS

- A. Kathy Belton Monthly Finance Report. Mrs. Belton reported the following:
 - Section A Cash and Investments. In the general fund section, the additional amount represents the ARP funds that have come in, and it has been transferred to the correct account. Any other increases would represent interest.
 - Page 2 The debt service reserve has been reduced. The quarterly payment was made for the 2009 bond.
 - Section B Revenues are up compared to last month. Some of this
 is due in part to taxes for vehicles. Overall, for the year, general
 fund is recognizing a profit for the month. Last month there were
 all the additional quarterly things that had to be paid.
 - Combined Utilities Revenues This is down compared to last month with not doing as well on the electric.
 - Page 2 Overall, expenses are increased. Combined utilities are performing well.
 - There were no general fund capital expenditures, however, one for the water plant.

- Section D Revenues were up compared to last year this time.
 Again, this is coming from the State funds and taxes.
- Expense was also up compared to last year coming from increased benefits.
- Combined Utilities Revenues are up compared to last year, which is a very good thing to see. Expense is also up compared to last year.

Chairman Chatman stated overall the Town's finances look good, and Mrs. Belton stated everything is in order.
